22/18 County Councillors Report: The Car Park/Garden at Porth Y Waen has been completed to a very high standard, this is a great improvement for the residents. All members to assembly at Porth Y Waen at 6.45pm on Tuesday 24th April, 2018 for a photography. Community Councillor A Jones mentioned that Mr. Arthur Williams is a very good photographer and the Clerk will ask him to take a photograph. County Councillor M Parry will forward a form to the Clerk to apply for a Grant from Group Cynefin for the Aberwheeler Sports. Many pot holes require attention on all minor roads in Aberwheeler.

23/18 Planning: 09/2017/1125 – Infill of void under bridge including flood relief culverts. Location: Candy Mill Bridge, Aberwheeler, Bodfari, Denbigh, LL16 4DR. Comments: Members approve the need for a safe bridge. Closing the bridge would cause great hardship for residents and road users as Candy Lane is a very narrow road unsuitable for large vehicles. However, Members are concerned that this engineering project must ensure no risk of flooding to "Candy Mill" a Grade2* listed building which is the only one in North Wales a complete traditional mill for cleaning clover seeds and milling corn.
