Matters Arising

(AR) Asked the Clerk to record that as he was not present at ACC meeting on Tuesday, 26 April, 2016. He had not been informed that the ACC AGM date was change to the 10th May, 2016. (AR) stated he would always attend the AGM. The Clerk apologised. The Clerk had sent e-mails to (AR) to inform him and other Community Councillors on the e-mail group list the date changed because of the Internal Audit procedure.

(JAJ) Asked (MP) if funds are available for us to purchase this land for a Car Park and Community Centre. (MP) Thought grants would be forthcoming.

(AR) Commented that he had visited Jones Peckover regarding the Starter Home. (MP)The three plots will be under Section 106.

(MP) Congratulated the Aberwheeler Sports Committee on a very successful event.
