33/25 Matters Arising. A new seat for the helicopter has arrived and installed by a qualified engineer in the Aberwheeler playing field.

34/25 Reports. County Councillor M Parry address the Meeting regarding the “Burst Water Main” problems up to the Castell Water Pipe possibly to be replaced in the next year. Andy Raynor of DCC Highways has been informed of work to be carried out in the Community on repairing pot holes.
