91/26 Confirm Previous Minutes. Received as a Correct Account.

92/26 Matters Arising. A detailed discussion took place regarding the Waun Chapel Cemetery. The Clerk will write to Mr Stephen Roberts and the Rev., Dr. Andras Iago to ask the following questions (i) are they going to remove the Oil tank and Oil from the present location. (ii) please confirm that ten thousand pounds (£10,000), will be credited following the sale of the Waun Chapel. (iii) also, it is very important that the boundary between the Chapel and the Cemetery is accurate before the sale is completed. An invitation was sent for Mr. Stephen Roberts and the Rev. Dr. Andras Iago to attend our next meeting.

County Councillor M Parry has informed the Clerk that Rebecca Williams of Denbighshire County Council has sent an email confirming the position on the transfer of the field to the Community Council to provide a letter of assurance for us to provide funders while we progress the transfer internally.
