Cyngor Cymuned Aberchwiler – Aberwheeler Community Council

Minutes of ACC on Tuesday, 27th September, 2016.

A presentation by Sarah Jones of Cadwyn Clwyd. The Denbighshire, Flintshire and Wrexham Local Action Groups have approved a new LEADER project called Red Telephone Box Regeneration. This project aims to provide a unique use for K6 Giles Gilbert Scott red telephone kiosks that are iconic features within the rural landscape. Many of them are under threat of removal and so need to be preserved as part of the rural landscape. The project will work by participating communities will work with an appointed consultant to design and deliver a suitable shell scheme which can be fitted into the kiosk to enable the community to use the facility in another form e.g. Tourist Information Point. Community Library, Defibrillator Station etc. Purchase the Red Telephone Box from BT at a cost of £1.00. But get them to paint it first and ask them to leave the electricity connection. Cost about £2,500. Match funding for ACC about £350.00, plus maintenance cost, electricity and Insurance. Members vote in favour of adopting the Red Telephone Kiosk as an information point.

Co-opt of Community Council vacancy. Dennis Michael Roberts, 16 Porth Y Waen, Aberwheeler has expressed an interest by letter, attended an interview and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office.
